Saturday workshops at Webster included "gay and rape workshops," described as "frank in their discussions. Personal feelings were shared among friends and strangers, and a feeling of sisterhood was definitely kindled."

Also offered were workshop on children's literature and black literature for "insight into non-racist and non-sexist areas." Gloria Steinem (white, straight woman) and Margaret Sloan (black, gay woman) both spoke with local women and attended "rap-ins" at forums.
